Atonement:

• You and I are sinners - Romans 3:23 & Romans 3:10 Think about sin in the legally guilty way, not in the earthly consequence way

- Jesus came for sinners: Matt 1:21
- Jesus died for sinners: Romans 5:8
- Jesus blood is our sin offering and does something the blood of animals never could: Hebrews 10:4 & Hebrews 9:12-14
- His sacrifice was perfect for all time: Hebrews 12:11-14

Justification:

Justification is the being made right "legally" before God. Remember think of sin not in its earthly consequences -Romans 3:23-26

• By Faith Alone! Ephesians 2:8-9

Good Ole Martin Luther and his problem with the Catholic Church - October 31st 1517

- Protestants = By Faith Alone
- Catholics = Faith + Means Of Grace (Eucharist, Mass, Confession, & ultimately purgatory)
- Is Christ's Blood Sufficient atonement?

Sanctification:

- A journey of killing sin and becoming more like Jesus Romans 8:11–13 & Hebrews 12:1–3
- Can I be perfect? (A short thought on the Holiness movement)

"The longer I have walked with Christ the more I have realized my overwhelming need."

Sanctification often is a journey of moving the boulder, stones, and sand.
