What is evangelism?

- A commitment to sharing the Gospel (The Good News of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection) with those who don't know it. (Worldwide or next-door)
- Are we supposed to evangelize? Matthew 28:18-20
- Okay, but I don't really want to, what's the big deal if I don't? - Romans 10:11-15
- Faith comes by hearing, the Gospel must be shared!
- Isn't evangelism a gift? What if I don't have it? Ephesians 4:11-12
- Some markings of gifted evangelist: Heart for the lost, willingness to go, Spirit led, and prayer centered (not exhaustive)
- While some might be more gifted than others, all must be willing to share the Good News of Jesus 1 Peter 3:15

Two Types Of Evangelism: Word And Deed

• These are not in competition. Jesus did both

Let's look at deed first:

- Practical
- Consistent
- Uncommon/Sacrificial
- "Them" Centered
- Sometimes it is as simple as an invitation
- Pointed back to Christ!
