Let's talk about the Trinity...

Sometimes people use three different names when referring to God: God or Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. But these are more than simply different names for one person; these are, in fact, the names of three very distinct persons. But even though God the father, God the Son (Jesus), and God the Holy Spirit have eternally existed as three distinct persons, there is only one God. This is called the doctrine of the Trinity. The idea of three persons and only one God is difficult to understand completely. Even so, it is one of the most important ideas of the Christian faith. -P.37 Christian Beliefs by Wayne Grudem

God The Son - Jesus Christ

- So is Jesus God or is he the son? Yes Colossians 2:9

God The Holy Spirit

- Present in Creation (Gen 1:1-2) & Baptism of Jesus
