### Baptism:

## How we Baptize:

- To immerse or plunge (Baptizo) someone into the water Mark 1:5, Mark 1:10, Romans 6:3-4
- A picture of going into the grave with Christ

# Who we Baptize:

- Consenting and confessed believers in Christ
- So why do some baptize infants?

# Who can Baptize people:

- A confessed believer in Christ who has been baptized
- The primary discipler or spiritual leader of that person

## What is the effect of baptism:

• Just a symbol vs a means of God's Grace?

## Is Baptism necessary for salvation?

- By Grace through Faith Ephesians 2:8-9
- Faith calls us to be obedience
