Translation Theory: How do we get the English Bible?

NIV Textual Basis: ... The Greek text used in translating the New Testament has been in the eclectic one, based on the latest edition of Nestle-Aland/United Bible Societies' Greek New Testament. The translators made their choices among the variant readings in accordance with the widely accepted principles of New Testament textual criticism. Footnotes call attention to the places where uncertainty remains.

The inerrancy of scripture

The inerrancy of scripture means that scripture in the original manuscripts does not affirm anything which is contrary to fact

- God has preserved through time what needed to be preserved for faith and practice.
